Brief History of LR's Development

CKL's Slideshow

Many serious amateurs and photo professionals now use only LR or LR for 80%-90% of their work.

LR is a "Workflow Facilitator"

LR's "Five Rules"

Five Modules

Library

Where the organization happens. Start here after importing a set of images.

Catalog shows things as they are on your HD's. Once you've put an image into your catalog, you should not move it with your OS (Windows Explorer or Macintosh Finder)! You can move any image or folder within LR! Your OS will show the move.

Add keywords in the Library

Rate your images in the Library

Deleting in the Library module can either remove an image from the catalog, leaving it on your HD or it can put the image in the trash.

Collections are specific for LR. They are not shown in the OS. However, collections are invaluable aids to selecting images for work in the Develop module.

Develop

The same controls that are available in Adobe Camera Raw (ACR) are available in LR. The difference is that LR maintains the history of what you've done while ACR does not.

Remember that anything done in LR is not applied to an image until it is exported or printed.

You can undo "forever"! You can undo what you just did or what you did yesterday or what you did last month.
